Richard Webby is a Member of the Department of Infectious Diseases at St Jude Children's Research Hospital, Memphis, USA. He leads a research program that focuses on the risk to human health caused by influenza viruses circulating in animal populations. This program collaborates with partners worldwide to combine field and laboratory studies to understand the scope and nature of influenza viruses circulating at the human-animal interfaces. Dr Webby is also the Director of the World Health Organization Collaborating Center for Studies on the Ecology of Influenza. In this role he contributes to influenza pandemic preparedness activities including assessing virus risks and developing candidate vaccine viruses to those of most concern.
