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Dr. Bruce Carpick received his B.Sc. in Biology and Physics and his Ph.D. in Medical Biophysics from the University of Toronto, Canada and did postdoctoral research in Cancer Biology at the *Cleveland Clinic Foundation, USA*. His research focus there was in purification, characterization, and structure-function analyses of peptides and proteins.
