Stephen Luby is a physician, epidemiologist and researcher who lived and worked in Karachi, Pakistan for 5 years at the Aga Khan University and in Dhaka, Bangladesh for 8 years at the International Centre for Diarrhoeal Research, Bangladesh. For the last 25 years Dr. Luby research efforts have engaged a broad array of health issues in low income countries. Dr. Luby currently serves as the Director for Research of Stanford's Center for Innovation in Global Health. He is also appointed as a Professor of Medicine (Infectious Diseases) and a Senior Fellow to Stanford's Woods Institute for the Environment and the Freeman Spogli Institute for International Studies. Dr. Luby is a prolific researcher who by deeply engaging with local collaborators has conducted extensive work assessing pandemic risks for Nipah and influenza viruses and strategies to reduce these risks.
