



David Bloom is Clarence James Gamble Professor of Economics and Demography at Harvard T.H. Chan School of Public Health (HSPH), Director of Harvard's National Institute of Aging Demography Center, and Director of HSPH's Value of Vaccination Research Network (funded by The Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation). Bloom also serves on the Board of Directors of the Population Association of America and is a founding co-editor of the *Journal of the Economics of Ageing*. Bloom's current research focuses heavily on the interplay of health, demographics, and economic growth and development. Bloom is an elected Fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences and an Andrew Carnegie Fellow of the Carnegie Corporation of New York.
