Guy Mathiolon is a French business leader, born on May 31, 1954, in Lyon. He is the CEO and majority shareholder of SERFIM Group, a mid-sized company comprising 31 firms with 2000 employees, specializing in various domains: infrastructure (energy, water, civil engineering, roads), environment (depollution, recycling, urban cleanliness, methanization), ICT (digital communication, video surveillance, fiber optics, traffic lights), industry, and Real Estate.

For several years, Guy Mathiolon has been featured in the ranking of the largest fortunes in France. He is also the President of GL Events Sport, the controlling entity of LOU RUGBY. From 2007 to 2011, he served as the first CGPME president of the Chamber of Commerce and Industry of Lyon.

Furthermore, he chaired the supervisory board (at its inception) of the Aéroports de Lyon (ADL) from 2007 to 2010, and in this capacity, he was the president of CASA, a structure that brings together all the CCI airport managers. He contributed to drafting a white paper on the strategy of airport platforms and their capital evolution.

Guy MATHIOLON is the CEO and majority shareholder of SERFIM Group France. He is also the author of the book "What if we bet on the ETIs?" written with entrepreneur Christophe Gruy (MAIA group). A former national member of CGPME and a member of the national management of the National Federation of Public Works, he often expresses his opinions in the press, for example, to advocate for ETIs (Intermediate-sized enterprises) and permanent contracts (CDIs). The newspaper La Tribune dubbed him "the Florentin" for his versatile approach.

As a member of the board of the Association of Alumni of École Centrale de Lyon, he is also the President of the Endowment Fund of ECL. He is a member of the executive committee of MEDEF AURA.
