



## Jean-Hugues TROUVIN

President of IABS-EU  
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Professor Jean-Hugues Trouvin holds a degree in pharmacy and a Doctorate of State in Pharmacology from the University of Paris. While serving as a professor of pharmacology and pharmacokinetics at the Faculty of Pharmacy at the University of Paris, he also worked as an assessor and expert for the French Agency for Health.

He served as the Director of Drug and Biological Product Evaluation at the French Agency for the Safety of Health Products (AFSSAPS) from 2001 to July 2007.

At the European level, he was part of the biotechnology/pharmacy working group (BWP) as the French representative since 1986. He was elected President of the BWP and re-elected for three additional terms.

He represented France on the Committee for Advanced Therapies (CAT) from its inception (2009) until September 2012. He contributed to the drafting of numerous guidelines, discussion papers, and parts of EU regulations and technical requirements for biological products, biotechnology-derived products, biosimilars, and innovative therapy drugs.

He currently serves as the President of IABS-EU, the European affiliate of IABS, and represents IABS-EU on the Board of the Endowment Fund.
