Michel Goldman, MD, PhD, is Professor Emeritus of Immunology at the Université libre de Bruxelles where he is the Founding President of the I3h Institute for Interdisciplinary Innovation in Healthcare.

He was the first Executive Director of the European Innovative Medicines Initiative (IMI). He is the Editor-in-Chief of *Frontiers in Medicine* and serves on the boards of the European Tuberculosis Vaccine Initiative, the Friends of the Global Fund Europe, and the Leadership Group of the Davos Alzheimer's Collaborative. Michel Goldman is a laureate of the Lucien Steinberg Prize (shared with Pr. Peter Piot, 1997), of the Quinquennial Prize of the Belgian National Fund of Scientific Research (2000), and of the Spinoza chair at the University of Amsterdam (2001). In 2007, Michel Goldman was awarded the degree of Doctor Honoris Causa of the Université of Lille.
