Professor Jean-Hugues Trouvin graduated in Pharmacy and received his State Doctorate in Pharmacology from the University of Paris. While working as Professor of Pharmacology and Pharmacokinetics at the Faculty of Pharmacy, University of Paris he has also been working as assessor and expert for the French Health authorities since 1986. In France, he was chairman of the French biotechnology working party from 1989 to 1993. He was Director of the Directorate for Evaluation of Medicinal products and Biologics at the French medicine agency (AFSSAPS) from 2001 to July 2007. At the European level, he has been working in the biotechnology/pharmacy working party (BWP) as French representative, since 1986. He has been elected as Chairman of the BWP and reelected for three new terms, he completed his mandate in February 2014. He was the French representative for the Committee for Advanced Therapy medicinal products (CAT) from its opening (2009) to Sept. 2012. He has been involved in the drafting of many guidelines, concept papers and part of the EU regulation and technical requirements for biologicals, biotechnology-derived products, biosimilars and lastly the advanced therapy medicinal products.

He is currently at the University Paris Descartes, School of Pharmacy, in the department of Health Product and Public Health, head of the Unit for Pharmaceutical Development and Innovation and, at the Central Pharmacy of the Parisian Hospital Group (AP-HP), head of the Research and Development department.
