

Olivier Espeisse (President IABS EU), Joris Vandeputte (IABS Past President) and Rick Hill (President IABS) attended the 92nd General Session World Organisation for Animal Health (WOAH) in Paris France as an official WOAH-recognized partner. In addition to a myriad of individual meetings with other attendees, the IABS delegation participated in the all the official events and break-out sessions (e.g., an invitation only

meeting of the Global Coordination Committee for ASF). The highlight of the meeting was the approval of a new memorandum of understanding between WOAH and IABS by the official WOAH delegates followed by a signature session and meeting with the WOAH

Director General. Several options for ongoing and future collaborations on topics like AMR and HPAI were discussed.




IABS Call for Volunteers
