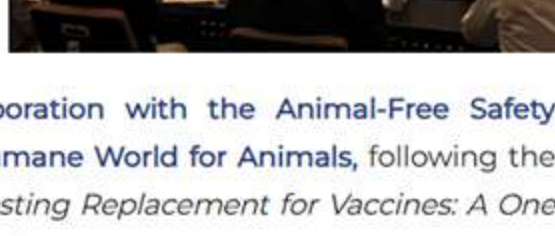
We are glad to share with you a new edition of the IABS Newsletter, bringing together the latest news and activities from the International Alliance for Biological Standardization.
