Etienne Thiry is Full Professor Emeritus of Veterinary Virology and Viral Diseases, University of Liege and Professor Emeritus at the Free University of Brussels. He is a member of the Royal Academy of Medicine and Secretary of the National Committee for Microbiology of the Royal Academies for Science and the Arts. He is Chair of the Veterinary Biologicals Committee of the International Alliance for Biological Standardization (IABS) and a member of the IABS Executive Committee. He is consulting member of the European Advisory Board on Cat Diseases. He is former Vice-Chair of the Board of Directors of Sciensano; former Chair of the Scientific Committee at the Belgian Food Safety Agency (Afsca); former chair of the Risk Assessment Group Covid Animals; and former Chair of the Expert Committee for Animal Health and Welfare at the French Agency Anses. His research interests cover several aspects of animal virology, in particular the study of virus-host interactions and the evolution of viral populations. These scientific activities have generated more than 500 articles in specialised scientific journals.
